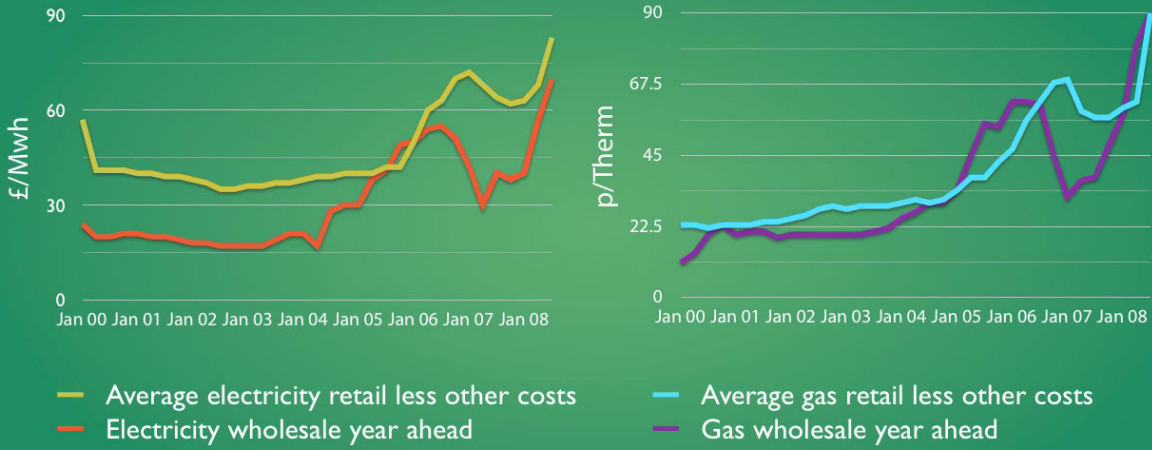

Electricity: 233 %

Gas: 718%
